Wheelchair seats are set in Stalls T5:8 and T29:32 for easy access. Seats at the end of Stalls rows F, G, H, J and L have a swing out armrest allowing wheelchair patrons to be transferred into them relatively easily if required.

An access lift for disabled patrons is available from the Ground Floor foyer down to Down Stairs at the Maj and the Museum of Performing Arts in the basement of the theatre. A foyer lift is available to all levels of the main auditorium seating.

The theatre is equipped with a Hearing Aid Loop system for patrons with hearing impairments. Patrons with hearing aids that have a T switch can be linked to the system without headphones. Accessible toilets are available within the Ladies and Gents restrooms located at the side of the main foyer on the Stalls (Ground floor) level.

First Aid is available during all public performances from members of the St John Ambulance who are on duty.

Barre Restaurant off the Main Foyer (Ground floor) is open Monday – Friday and for all performances.

PROSCENIUM AND STAGE DIMENSIONS

Proscenium opening: Height 9.140m Width – 10.150m

House curtain: Bronze velvet pleated curtain, with a split in the centre, counterweighted to fly, hand operated from OP -opposite prompt side, resident on Line 1.

Stage Measurements:

Stage width wall to wall	21.05m
Front of stage to back wall	19.95m

Machinery:

78 sets of single purchase counterweights at 150mm centres, operated from OP side. Counterweights barrels able to be ganged for greater loads.

Stage surface:

The stage floor is flat with no rake and consists of 35mm pine with 6mm masonite cover over the entire surface.

ORCHESTRA PIT

Width of pit wall to wall	10.000m
Depth of pit from stage floor	2.600m

Storage chamber under stage behind orchestra pit with folding door access from pit and roller door at rear for access to fork lift for loading. Size of chamber – 10.000m x 10.700m

The orchestra pit has three different configurations: Small 5-15 players no seats removed; Medium 20-25 players with A Row removed ; Large 40-70 players with Rows A,B and C removed .

Ballet flooring:

For all ballet performances, black tarkett is placed over the stage area 13.000m wide and from front edge of stage to cyclorama (back screen).

Control System:

1 x Strand 500i lighting console

Performance Relay:

Installed throughout the theatre foyers and dressing rooms etc. Video Monitors are located in each foyer Front of House, as well as in the Green Room, the Stage Door and in the Booking Office.

DRESSING ROOMS

All artists' dressing rooms are located on the Prompt side of the stage on two levels. The capacity quoted below, is based on one person per bench with individual lit mirror.
